Repurposed Architecture

DESCRIPTION The Mississippi Hardware Co. building sits on a corner lot covering 3.3 acres at the intersection of Washington St. and Veto St. across the street from the Vicksburg Convention Center. The project transforms a once river harbor warehouse three-story building into a state-of-the-art learning center that will host: (1) an entrepreneurial center - a combination of experimental, computational, and interactive workspaces; (2) a graduate center - a specialized educational center that allows for advanced science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and business programs; and a (3) State Technology Transfer Center - a programmatic enclave where new and existing Mississippi businesses can work directly with federal and local programs to advance their technology and business concepts.

VISION This project aims to leverage the historical value of the existing building and invest in the activation of the site by offering a progressive learn\work environment.
